- We need to perform an official task in the public interest (i.e. in order to provide a child with an education).

4.4.2 Less commonly we may also use your child's personal data where:

- We have obtained consent to use it in a certain way.
- We need to protect the individual's health interests (or someone else's interest).

4.4.3 Where we have obtained consent to use child's data, this consent can be withdrawn at any time. We will make this clear when we ask for consent and explain how consent can be withdrawn.

4.4.4 Some of the reasons listed above for collecting and using your child's personal data overlap, and dx82 67-3 (w51 TjTJ0.0u 2.38-32) 2.3 (62)



- Youth Support Services - as it has legal responsibilities regarding the education or training of 13-19 year-olds.
- Educators and examining bodies - necessary for the performance of our education function.
- Our regulator, Ofsted - to enable it to evaluate the education we provide to your child, which is in the public interest.
- Suppliers and service providers - to enable them to provide the service we have contracted them for.
- Health and social welfare organisations / third parties - to enable us to comply with our duty of care and statutory safeguarding duties for your child's wellbeing, including:
 - Therapists, clinical psychologists.
 - Academy medical staff / nurse.
 - School counsellors.
 - CAMHS (Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service).
 - Social care.
 - Educational Welfare Officer (EWO). ○



- 4.10.1 Once your child reaches the age of 13, we are legally required to pass on certain information about them to the local authority or youth support services provider in your area, as it has legal responsibilities regarding the education or training of 13-19 year-olds.
- 4.10.2 This information enables it to provide Youth Support Services, post-16 education and training services, and careers advice.
- 4.10.3 Parents/carers, or children once aged 16 or over, can contact their Academy Data Champion to ask to request that we only pass the student's name, address and date of birth to your local authority or Youth Support Services provider

- 4.11.1 Where we share data with an organisation that is based outside the European Economic Area, share with a

- Object to the use of personal data if it would cause, or is causing, damage or distress.
- Prevent it being used to send direct marketing.
- Object to decisions being taken by automated means (by a computer or machine, rather than by a person).
- In certain circumstances, have inaccurate personal data corrected, deleted or destroyed, or restrict processing.
