4.3 Why DRET uses this Data

- 4.3.1 We will process your personal data when you register and attend an event. This is to assist us with understanding how many individuals will attend an event and the arrangements that we have to put in place to ensure that the event can operate appropriately.
- 4.3.2 We value your interest and would like to keep in touch with you. We would like to use your personal details for the purpose of sending you marketing materials such as invitations to future events, newsletters and vacancies by post and email.

4.4 Our Lawful Basis for Using this Data

- 4.4.1 We only collect and use personal information about you when the law allows us to. Most commonly, we use it where we need to:
 - Book and manage an event on the grounds of our legitimate interest.
- 4.4.2 We will process your personal data in the case of communication by email for marketing purposes on the basis of your consent. You have the right to opt out of this type of processing at any time.
- 4.4.3 Less commonly, we may also use personal information about you where:
 - You have given us consent to use it in a certain way.
 - We need to protect your vital interests (or someone else's interests).
 - It is required for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims, or whenever courts are acting in their judicial capacity.
- 4.4.4 Where you have provided us with consent to use your data, you may withdraw this consent at any time. We will make this clear when requesting your consent, and explain how you go about withdrawing consent if you wish to do so. More detail is contained in the Trust's Data Protection Policy.
- 4.4.5 Some of the reasons listed above for collecting and using personal information about you overlap, and there may be several grounds which justify the Trust's use of your data.

4.5 Collecting Information

4.5.1 Whilst the majority of information we collect from you is mandatory, there is some information that you can choose whether or not to provide to us. Whenever we seek to collect information from you, we will make it clear whether you must provide this information (and if so, what the possible consequences are of not complying), or whether you have a choice.

4.6 How DRET Stores the Data

4.6.1 The data collected will be stored securely on a on the Trust's secure storage system.

4.7 Data Sharing

4.7.1 We do not share personal information about you with any third party without your consent unless the law and our policies allow us to do so.

4.8 Transferring Data Internationally

4.8.1 Where we transfer personal data to a country or territory outside the European Economic Area, we will do so in accordance with data protection law.
